Children will encounter a dynamic setting where our staff takes on roles in various establishments, including a church, court, casino, beauty parlour, restaurant, and police officers' station. children will have the opportunity to: Get a job at one of the establishments; Get married and adopt children; Apply for business licenses and start their own ventures; Earn currency to buy food and other essentials.

Throughout the day, children will immerse themselves in this interactive world, learning valuable life skills while having fun. Currency is issued to all participants, with options to spend wisely or save for future endeavours. Children can get themselves something to eat at the restaurant and in case of need, the church offers shelter and sustenance with apples and bread.

REQUIREMENTS

Your service area will need to consist of an environment that allows for enough space for the children to engage in the activity as well as be supervised. Tenggrenplay will assess and advise upon the onsite visit.

BENEFITS AND OUTCOMES

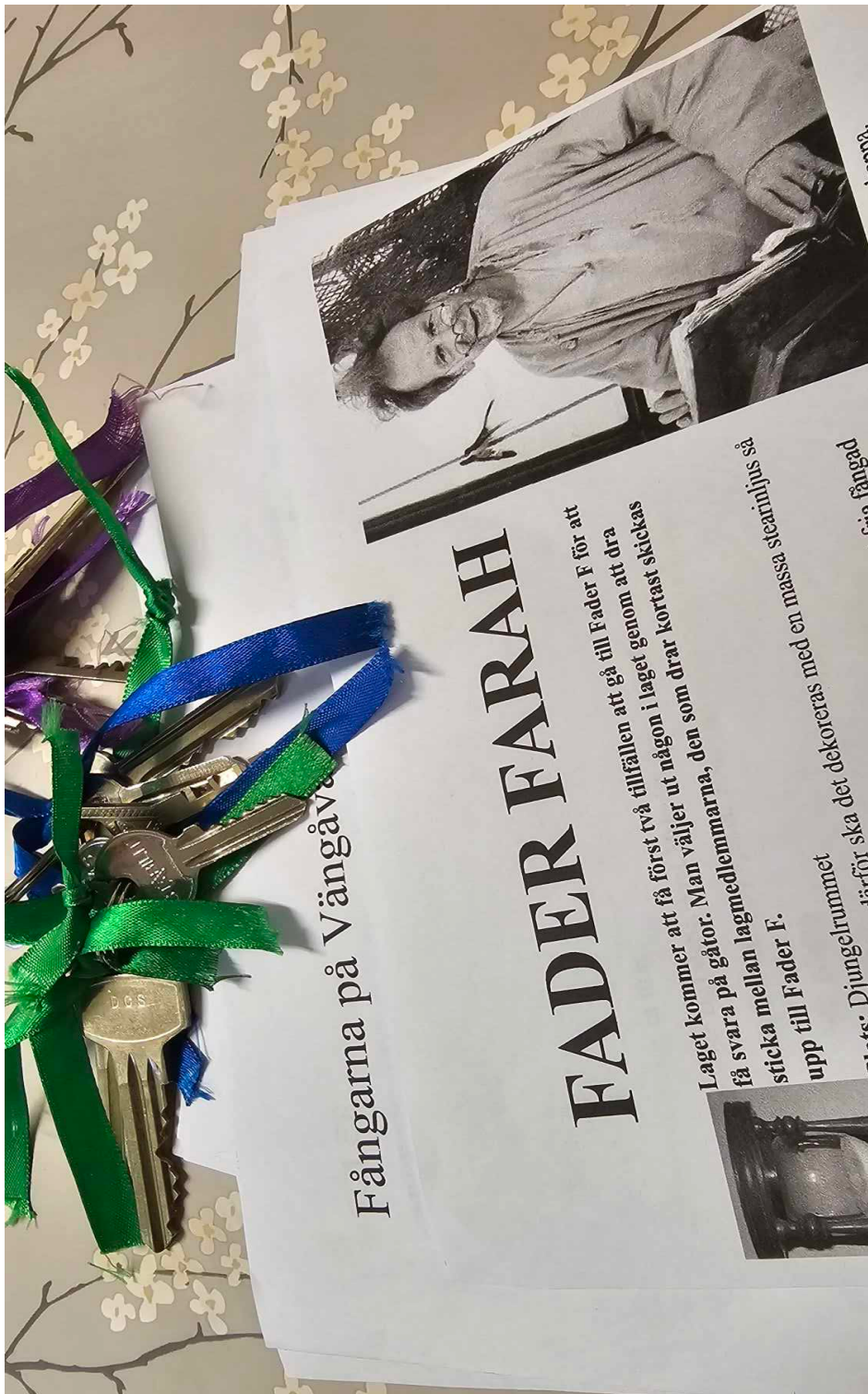

Midsummer, celebrated around the summer solstice, marks the longest day of the year and is a time for community, nature, and celebration. During the day, children will take part in a variety of traditional Swedish activities that bring the spirit of Midsummer to life.

Children will create flower crowns—a key part of Midsummer attire—and discover the folklore and symbolism behind them. Through games, music, stories, and crafts, they’ll explore the deep connection Swedes have with nature and seasonal change during this special time of year.

The cultural tradition of Midsummer is known in many parts of the world, but its roots run deep in Swedish heritage. This incursion offers children a unique opportunity to experience Midsummer from an authentic Swedish perspective, bringing the customs and spirit of the celebration to life through engaging and meaningful activities.

THE SWEDISH WAY

Swedish Midsummer, or *Midsommar*, is one of the most beloved celebrations in Sweden, marking the arrival of summer and the longest day of the year. Held in late June, usually around the summer solstice, Midsummer is all about nature, light, and joyful traditions. Families and communities gather outdoors to raise and dance around the *midsommarstång* (maypole), often while singing traditional Swedish songs. Children and adults wear flower crowns made from freshly picked wildflowers, and the air is filled with music, laughter, and the scent of summer blooms. Games and folk dances are a big part of the day, with everyone joining in.

Midsummer is also connected to old folklore, including the belief that placing seven different flowers under your pillow can make you dream of your future love. It’s a magical time full of fun, tradition, and appreciation for the beauty of Swedish natur

BENEFITS AND OUTCOMES

The incursion offers children a special opportunity to experience Christmas from an authentic Swedish perspective, exploring traditional customs, stories, and celebrations that have been passed down for generations.

THE SWEDISH WAY

Swedish Christmas, or *Jul*, is a deeply cherished holiday filled with warmth, tradition, and festive joy. Celebrations begin early in December, with homes decorated in glowing candles, paper stars, and straw ornaments. A key part of the season is *Advent*, marked by lighting candles each Sunday leading up to Christmas, and *St. Lucia's Day* on December 13th, when children dress in white and sing songs to celebrate light during the darkest time of the year.

The main celebration happens on *Julafton* (Christmas Eve), when families gather to share a traditional meal called the *julbord*, which includes meatballs, pickled herring, ham, potatoes, and rice pudding. After the meal, it's time for the arrival of *Jultomten*—the Swedish Santa—who brings gifts, often handed out in person with a friendly visit. Throughout the season, there is a strong focus on togetherness, tradition, and creating a cozy atmosphere known as *julmys*. Swedish Christmas is a magical blend of folklore, faith, and festive cheer that brings families and communities together.

THE SWEDISH WAY

Swedish Easter, or Påsk, is a colourful and joyful celebration that blends Christian traditions with old folklore and springtime festivity. In the lead-up to Easter, homes are decorated with bright feathers, painted eggs, birch twigs (*påskris*), and cheerful yellow chicks to welcome the arrival of spring. One of the most unique traditions is children dressing up as *påskkäringar*—Easter witches—with painted cheeks, headscarves, and old clothes. They go door to door, much like Halloween, handing out handmade Easter cards in exchange for sweets.

While Easter Sunday marks the religious aspect of the holiday, the overall celebration in Sweden is more about spending time with loved ones, enjoying the spring season, and taking part in fun, creative traditions that have been passed down for generations.
